CDL Skills Test Waiver Application for Military Personnel Information Sheet

DL-408A
(Rev. 8/14)

While other states or entities may provide similar versions of the application, South Carolina Department of Motor Vehicles only accepts this Form DL-408A. This form may only be completed by service members who are currently licensed and who are or were employed within the past year (12 months) in a military position requiring the operation of a military motor vehicle equivalent to a Commercial Motor Vehicle (CMV). It must be completed and signed by the service member and his Commanding Officer (pay grade O-4 or above) and is valid for 90 days from the Commanding Officer's date of signature.

The transfer of School Bus (S) and/or Passenger (P) endorsements under this Waiver Program are prohibited.

- A. This is a list of requirements that must be met before SCDMV can consider issuing you a Commercial Driver's License (CDL) skills test waiver.
1. You must hold a valid South Carolina driver's license.
 2. Complete SCDMV Form ***DL-408A CDL Skills Test Waiver Application for Military Personnel***. You and your Commanding Officer (pay grade O-4 or above) must sign the completed Form DL-408A.
 3. Make a copy of your Active Duty/Reservist Military ID card or a DD-214 that shows your discharge status (dishonorable discharge does not qualify).
- B. Submit your completed Form DL-408A along with a copy of your military ID or DD-214 using one of the following options.

- C. You will be notified by mail once your application is processed.
1. If the application is approved, the service member may be issued a CDL without having to take the skills test. The service member must first meet all other requirements for the classification of commercial license he or she is seeking before the credential can be issued, such as:
 - Complete additional DMV forms required for a CDL
 - Declare the type of commerce in which you intend to operate
 - Provide a DOT Medical Examiner's Certificate, if applicable
 - Successfully pass applicable CDL knowledge tests
 - Successfully pass the vision screening examination for a CDL
 - Pay all applicable DMV fees
 2. If you do not meet all of the requirements listed or this document cannot be verified, you will be required to pass the commercial driver's license skills tests.
