SCDMV PROVIDES USED PLATES TO NATIONAL GUARD

Mt. Pleasant, SC – Representatives from the South Carolina Department of Motor Vehicles (SCDMV) will visit the Mt. Pleasant Army National Guard today to deliver used South Carolina license plates requested by soldiers in Iraq and Afghanistan. The plates, which were slated for the recycle bin, will be mounted on National Guard humvees and other military vehicles.

“The Guardsmen requested the plates because they wanted to show their South Carolina pride while serving overseas. We are more than happy to accommodate them,” said Executive Director Marcia Adams.

Because the plates were used, SCDMV is able to provide them at no cost to the state. Used plates, which have been turned in by vehicle owners, are returned to the SCDMV warehouse for recycling.

“Our employees in the warehouse really enjoyed choosing the plates for the soldiers. It means so much to all of us to be able to show our support for the troops,” said Adams.
