NEW DMV SATURDAY HOURS

Columbia, S.C. – September 10, 2003 – The South Carolina Department of Motor Vehicles will once again offer Saturday services beginning September 13 in six DMV branch offices. The Saturday service hours, which were scheduled to end in August, have been extended due to positive customer response.

“It’s a service our customers seem to appreciate,” said Marcia Adams, Acting DMV Executive Director. “The Saturday hours just make it more convenient for customers and that’s our goal—making it easier to do business with DMV.”

Although the service is not new, some changes have been made to the Saturday services DMV offers. The offices will now be open from 8:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. instead of the full day service previously provided. The Lexington DMV office will also replace the Irmo-Ballentine office, which will now be closed on Saturdays.

“Based on the office activity for the past two months, we’ve found that most customers prefer to visit the offices during the morning,” Adams said. “By opening the offices for a half day, we are still providing the services our customers want, but we’re also saving money.”

“I’m pleased that DMV is continuing to offer the Saturday hours,” said Governor Mark Sanford. “DMV is proving that you can provide better services to the citizens of South Carolina even during these tight budget times.”
