### **FIVE NEW LICENSE PLATES AVAILABLE**

**Blythewood, SC** – The South Carolina Department of Motor Vehicles (SCDMV) announced today the availability of five new specialty license plates.

The Carolina Panthers, the Kiwanis International Foundation, the Choose Life S.C., the SC Ancient Free and Accepted Masons and the Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity license plates are now available in SCDMV offices across the state.

The fee for the Carolina Panthers license plate is \$70 every two years in addition to the regular motor vehicle registration fee. The Carolina Panthers plate is available to the general public and has no special requirements for acquiring the plate. A portion of the fees collected for the plate will be distributed to the SC Department of Parks, Recreation and Tourism and the State Park Service for recreational improvements.

The fee for the Kiwanis International Foundation license plate is \$30 every two years in addition to the regular vehicle registration fee. The plate is available to the general public and there are no special requirements for acquiring it. A portion of the fees collected for the Kiwanis International Foundations plate will be used for financial assistance to the Carolinas Kiwanians District.

The Choose Life S.C. plate is \$35 every two years in addition to the regular vehicle registration fee. The plate is available to the general public and has no special requirements for acquiring the plate. A portion of the fees collected will be distributed to SC Citizens for Life/AKA Choose Life S.C. to support pregnancy care centers.

The SC Ancient Free and Accepted Masons plate is \$30 every two years in addition to the regular vehicle registration fee. To obtain a SC Ancient Free and Accepted Masons plate, customers must be a member of a Masonic Lodge and present a current dues card or a letter from a Masonic Lodge Secretary authorizing an honorary member or any person duly authorized by that officer to purchase a plate.

The Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity plate is \$70 every two years in addition to the regular vehicle registration fee. The plate is available to members of the fraternity who must present a current membership card, a life membership plate or a letter from the District Director on district letterhead. Plate fees for the Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity will be used for scholarships
