### **TWO NEW DIGITAL LICENSE PLATES AVAILABLE**

**Blythewood, S.C. – October 1, 2009** – The South Carolina Department of Motor Vehicles (SCDMV) announced today the availability of two new specialty license plates. The Greenville Children’s Hospital and the U.S. Naval Academy license plates are now available.

“These new plates are the first license plates to be issued through SCDMV’s digital ‘on demand’ process,” said SCDMV Executive Director Marcia Adams. “The plates will not be stocked in field offices, but will be printed and mailed to customers as they are ordered.”

The Greenville Children’s Hospital license plate is available to the general public and has no special requirements. The fee is \$30.00 every two years in addition to the regular motor vehicle registration fee. A portion of the fees collected for the plate will be used by the Greenville Hospital System to purchase hospital equipment for the children’s hospital.

The U.S. Naval Academy (USNA) license plate fee is \$30.00 in addition to the regular motor vehicle registration fee and is available to USNA alumni only. To apply for the plate, applicants must submit a form DD214 and their USNA diploma or a letter from the USNA Alumni Association indicating their eligibility. A portion of the fees collected will be distributed to the USNA Alumni Association.

Interested customers may place their license plate orders by mail or at any SCDMV field office. Applications will be processed within three to five business days.
