SCDMV ACCEPTING PREPAID APPLICATIONS FOR VETERAN SPECIALITY LICENSE PLATES

Blythewood, SC – The South Carolina Department of Motor Vehicles (SCDMV) has been authorized to issue a Veteran specialty plate for use on private passenger motor vehicles and motorcycles registered to SC residents who have served in the United States Armed Forces, active or reserve components, and have been honorably discharged from service.

SCDMV must receive 400 prepaid applications for each type of plate prior to producing the plate. Qualified individuals may submit their application and deposit through the mail or at their local field office.

For a passenger plate, applicants must submit the following:

- Completed [MV-37A](#) (form available online and in all field offices)
- Copy of DD-214 showing honorable discharge
- **\$12.00 Deposit** *Check or Money Order*

For a motorcycle plate, applicants must submit the following:

- Completed [MV-37B](#) (form available online and in all field offices)
- Copy of DD-214 showing honorable discharge
- **\$5.00 Deposit** *Check or Money Order*

SCDMV will hold the application and the deposit until 400 applications have been received. If SCDMV has not received the required 400 prepaid applications by July 1, 2009, all applications and deposit checks or money orders will be returned to the applicant.
